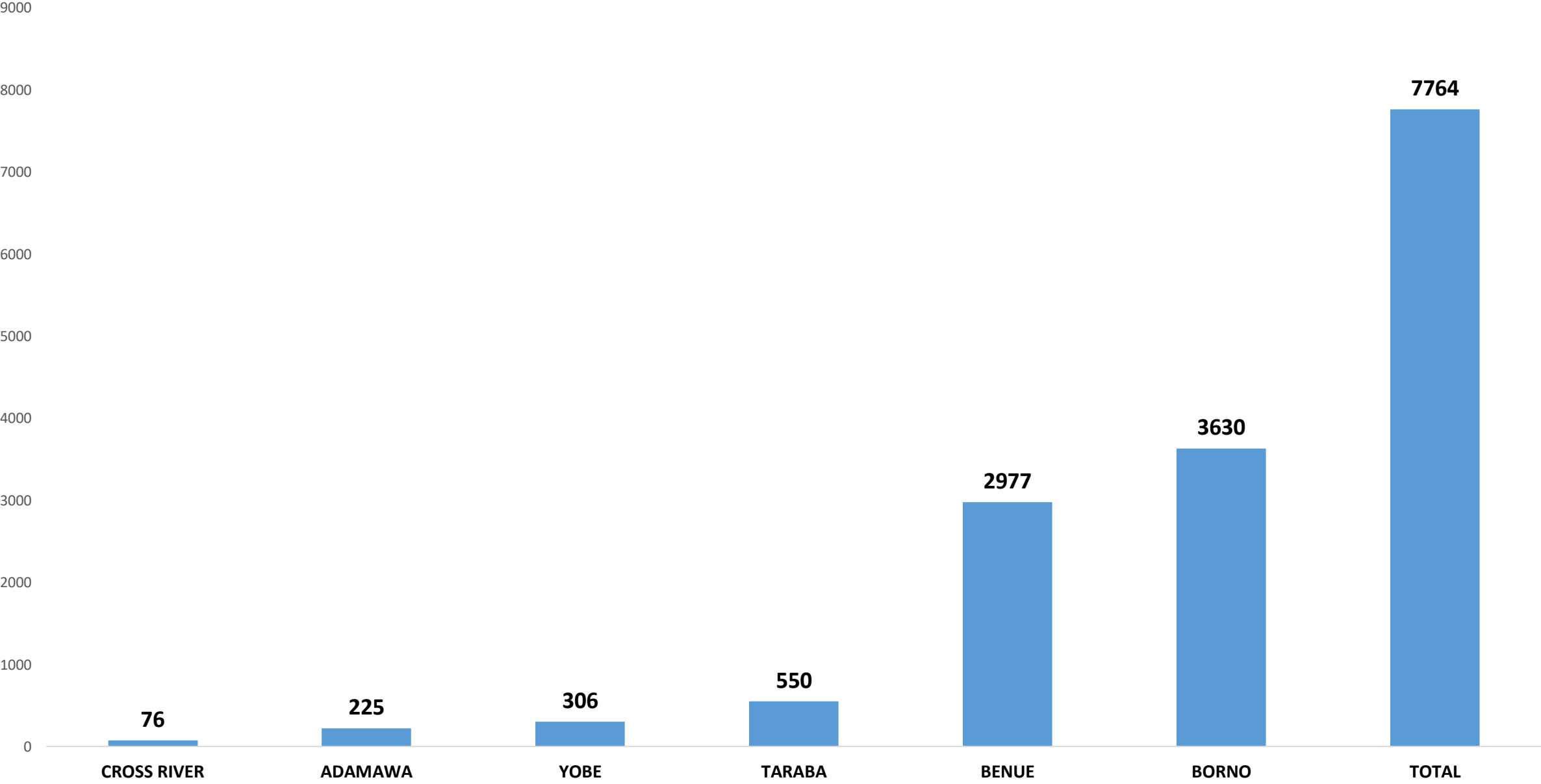

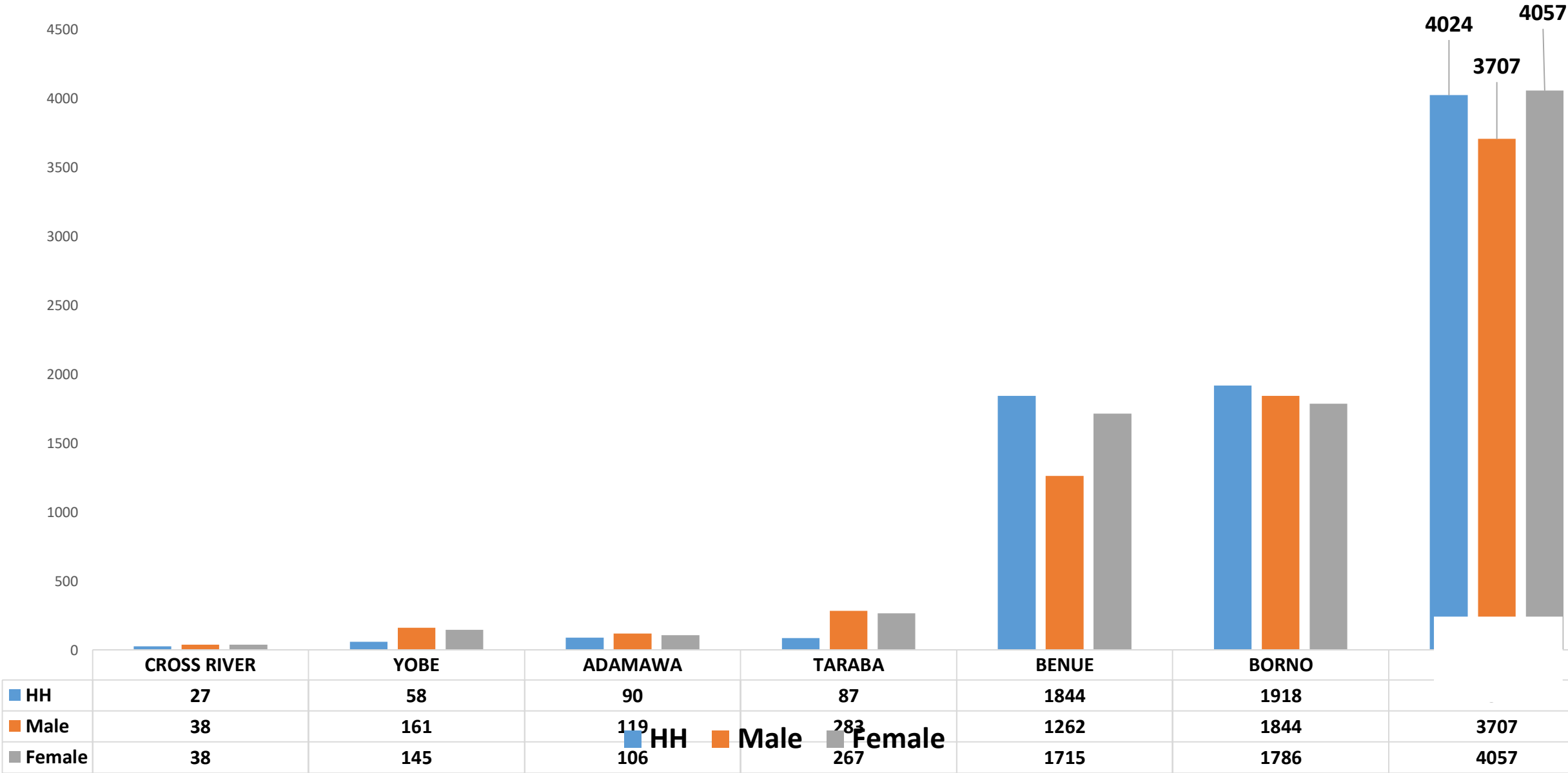

Internal/Forced Displacements of Populations across Project States (May-Jun 2026)

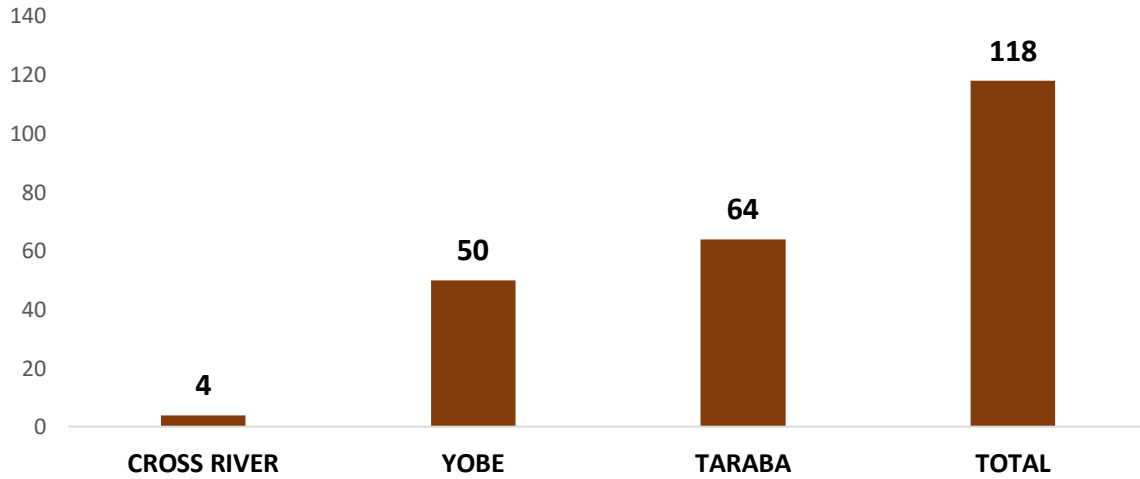


Gender & Household disaggregation of IDPs/FDPs Across Project States

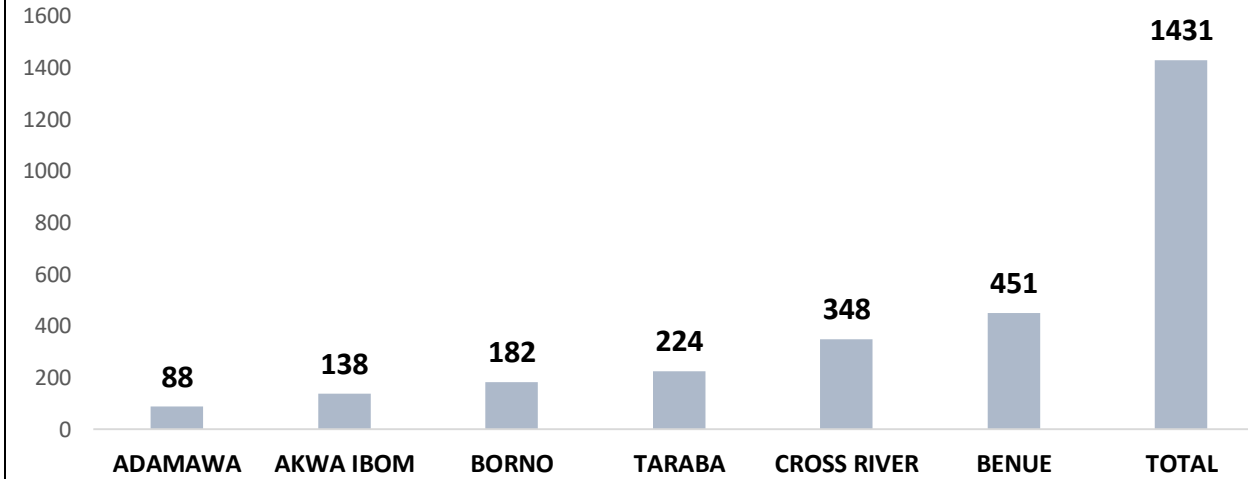

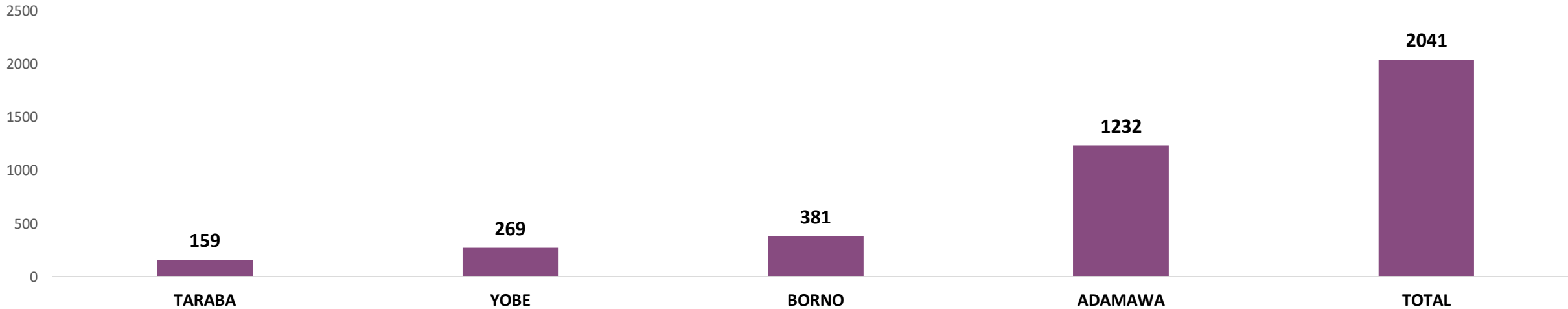

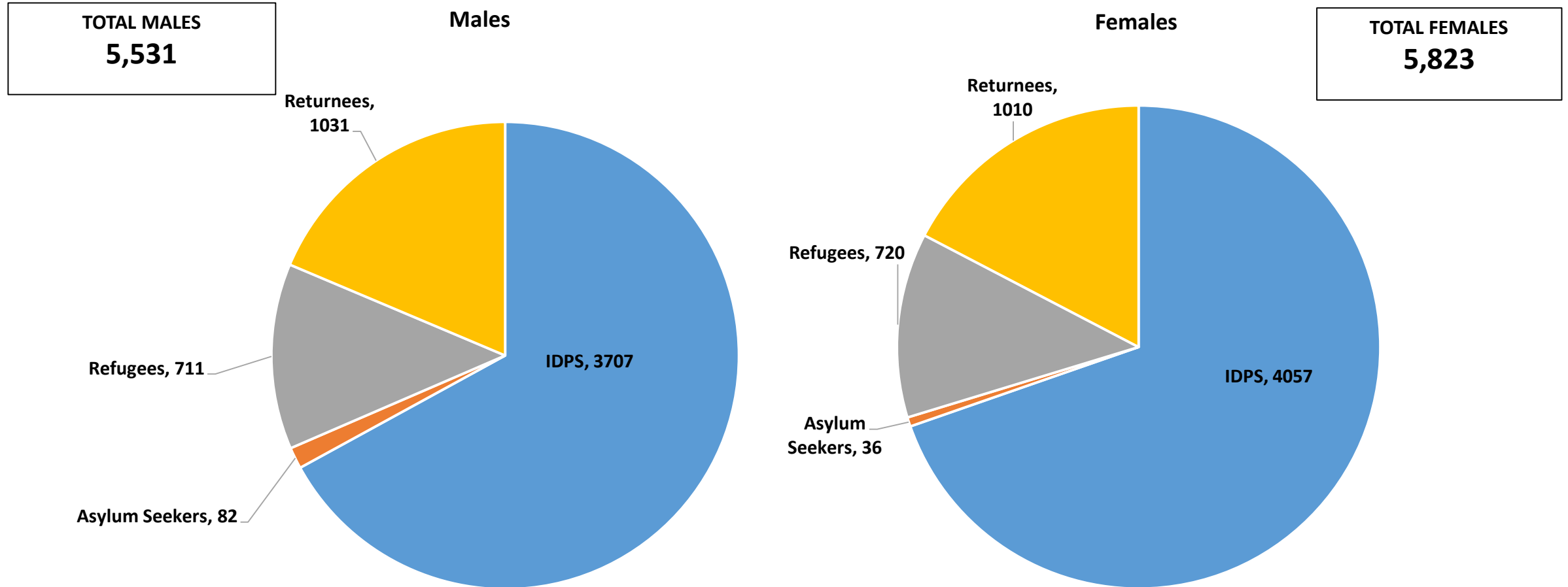
Total Refugees (May-Jun 2026)



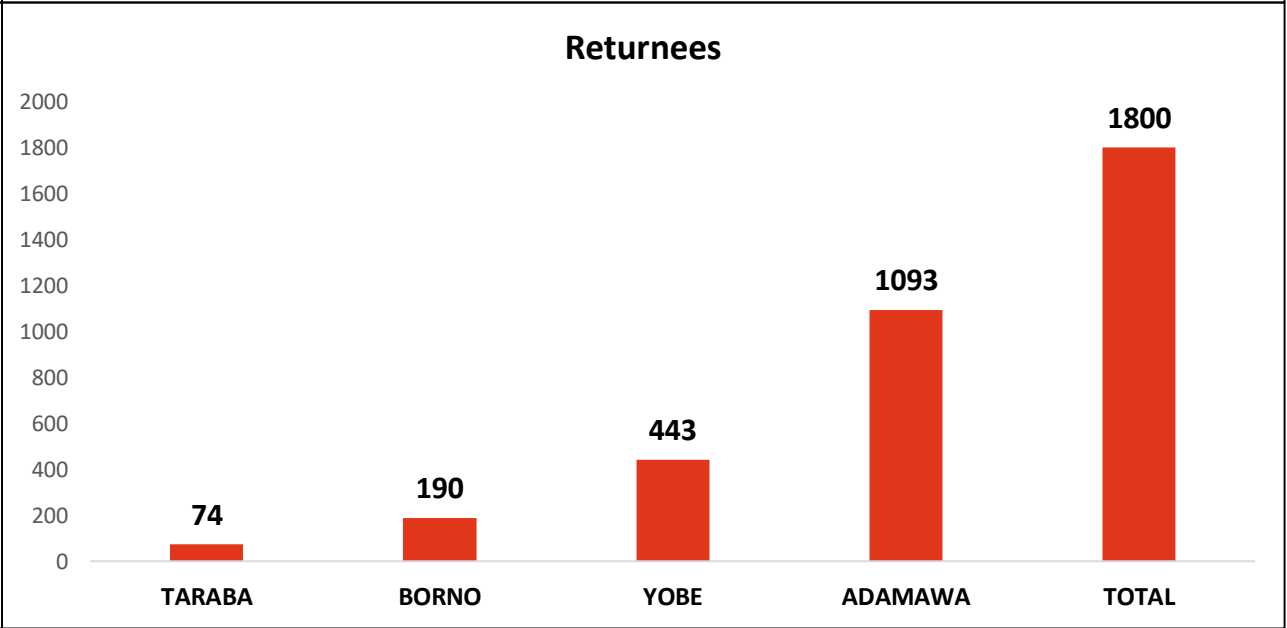
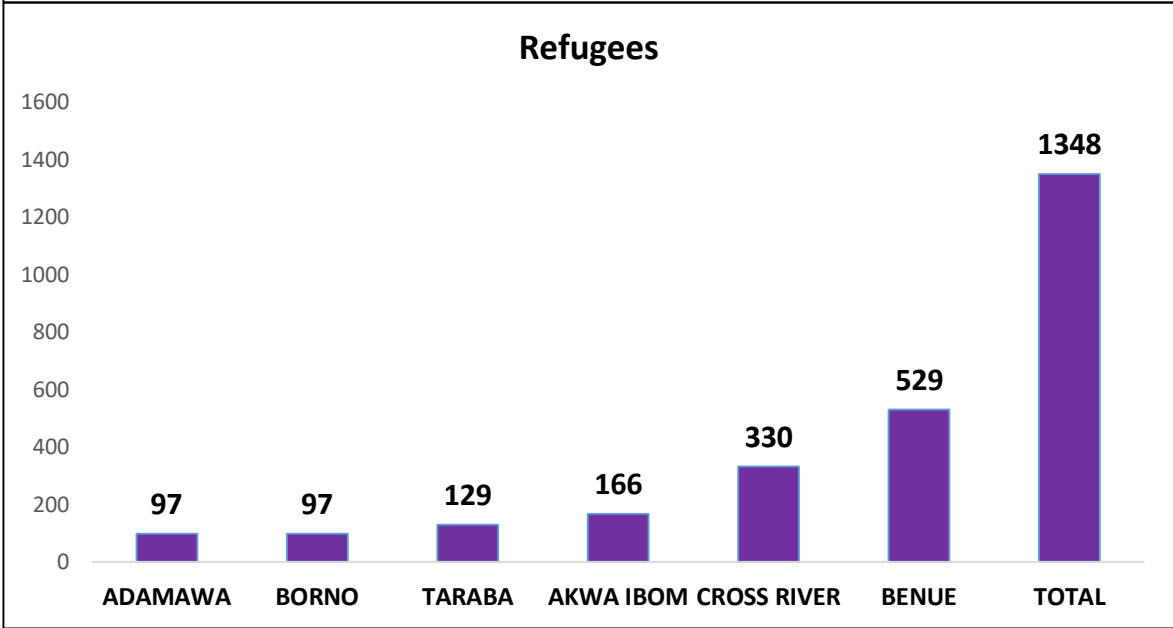
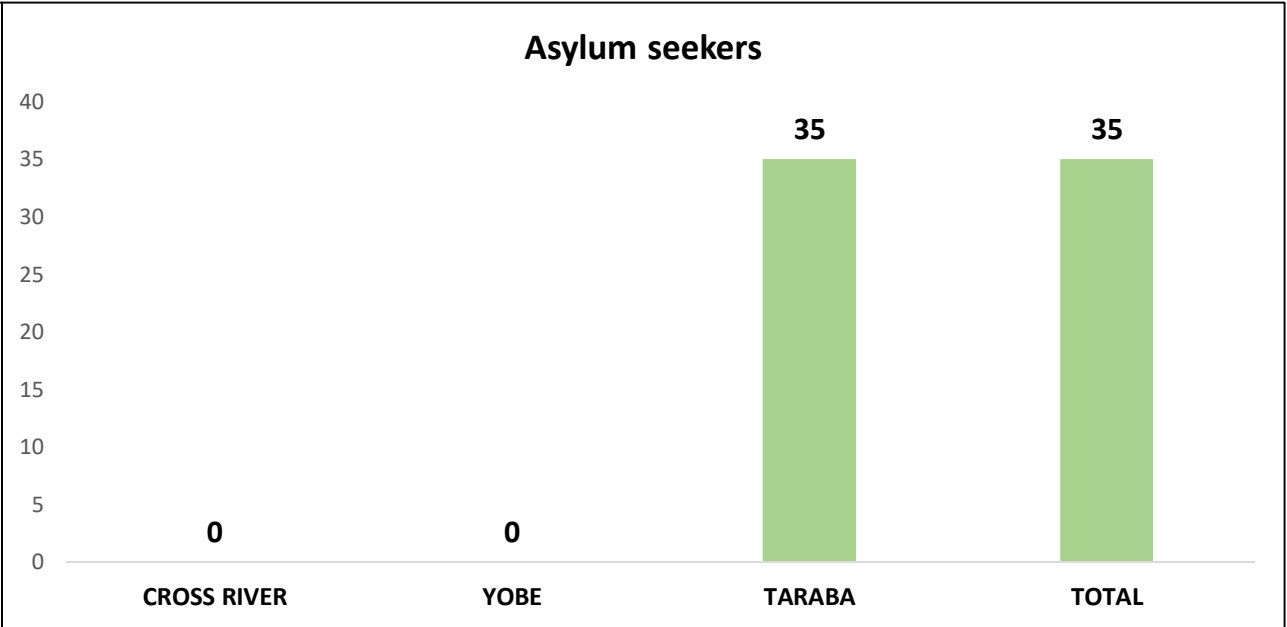
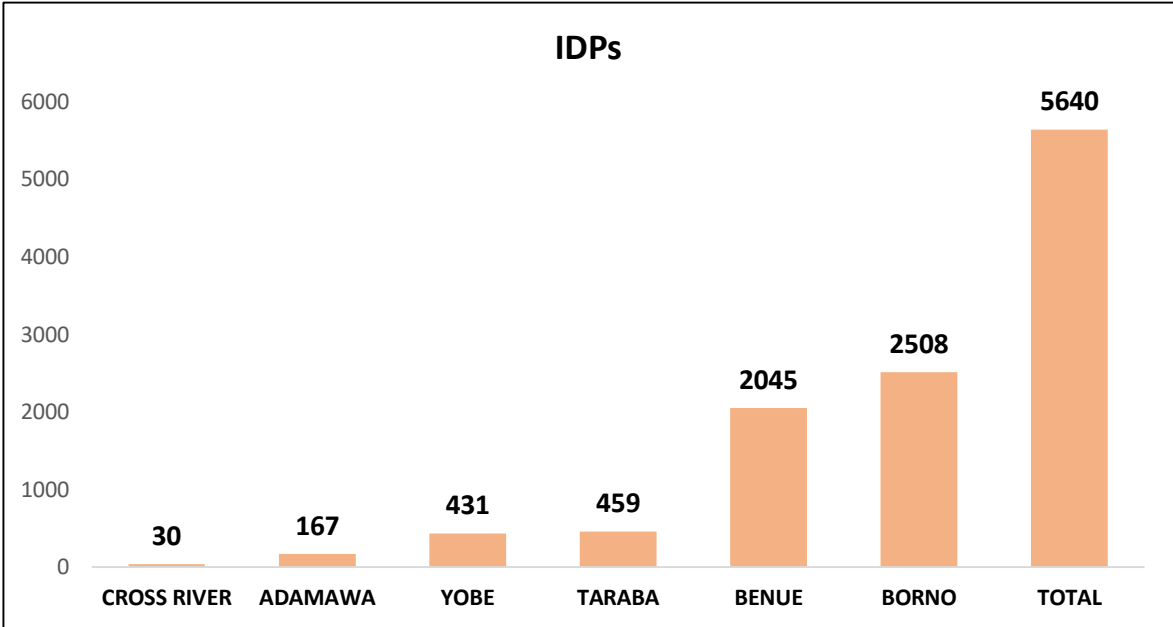

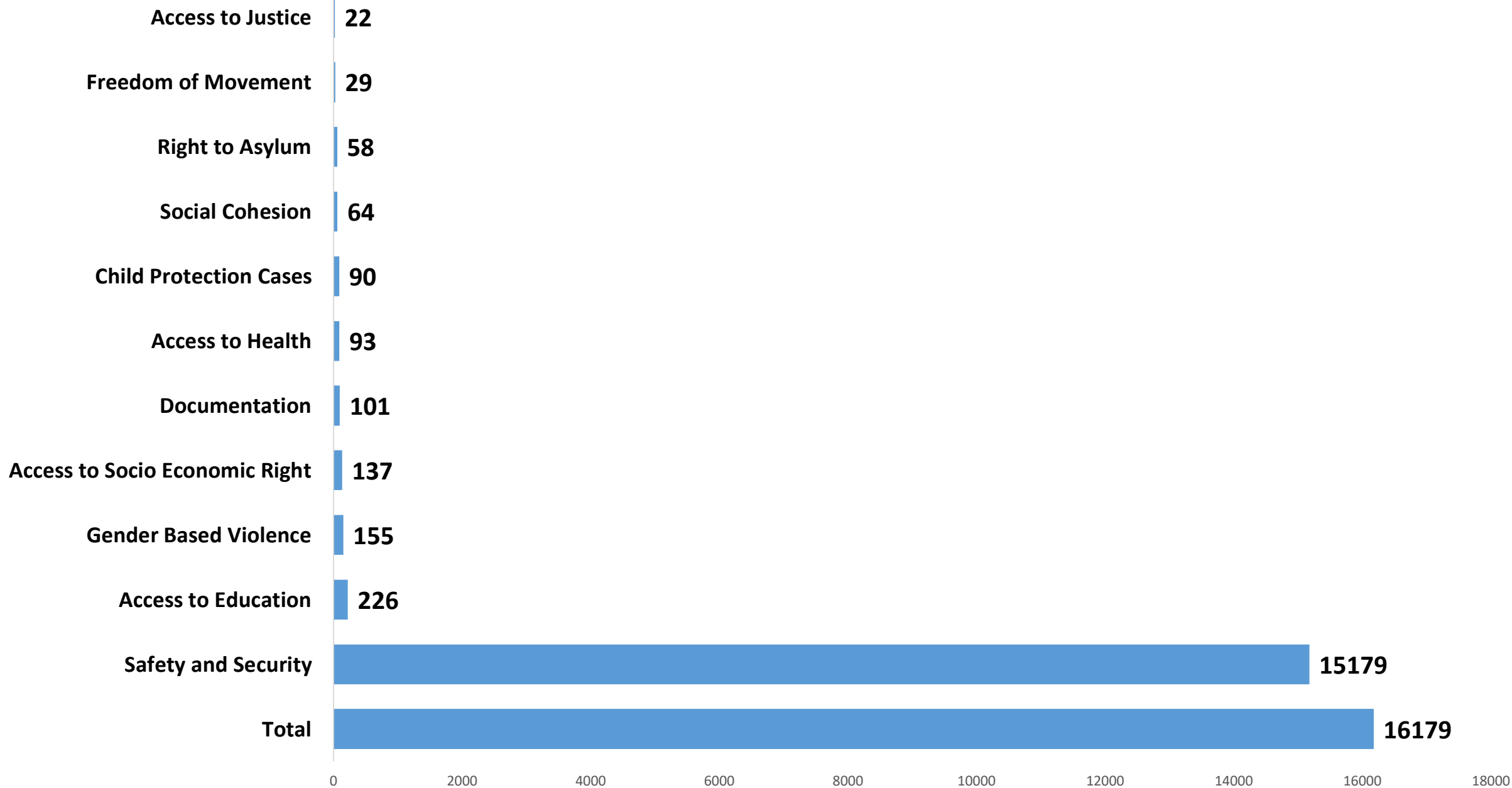
Total Gender Disaggregation of IDPs, Refugees, Asylum Seekers and Returnees (May-Jun 2026)



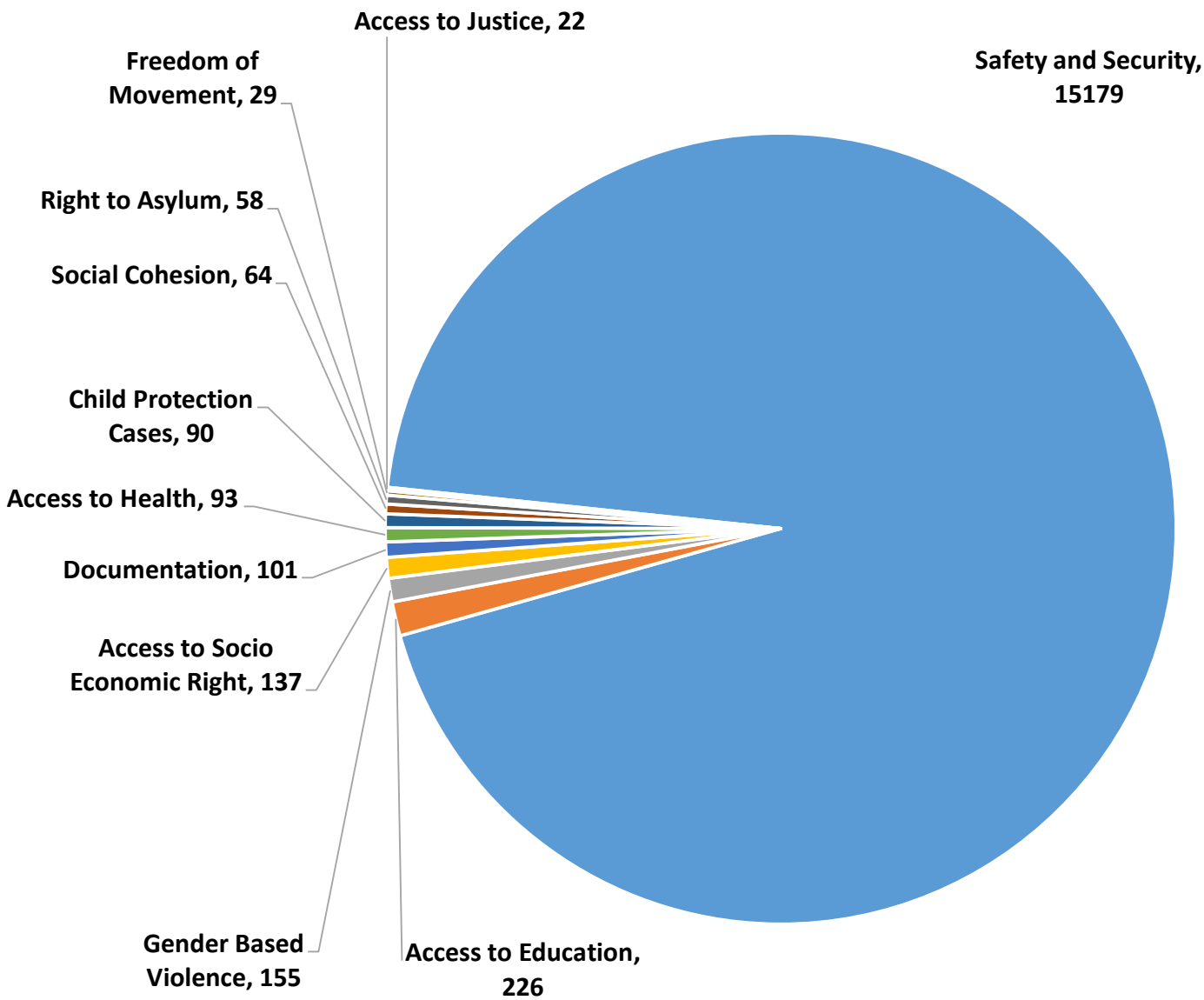
Total Children of IDPs, Refugees, Asylum Seekers and Returnees (May-Jun 2026)

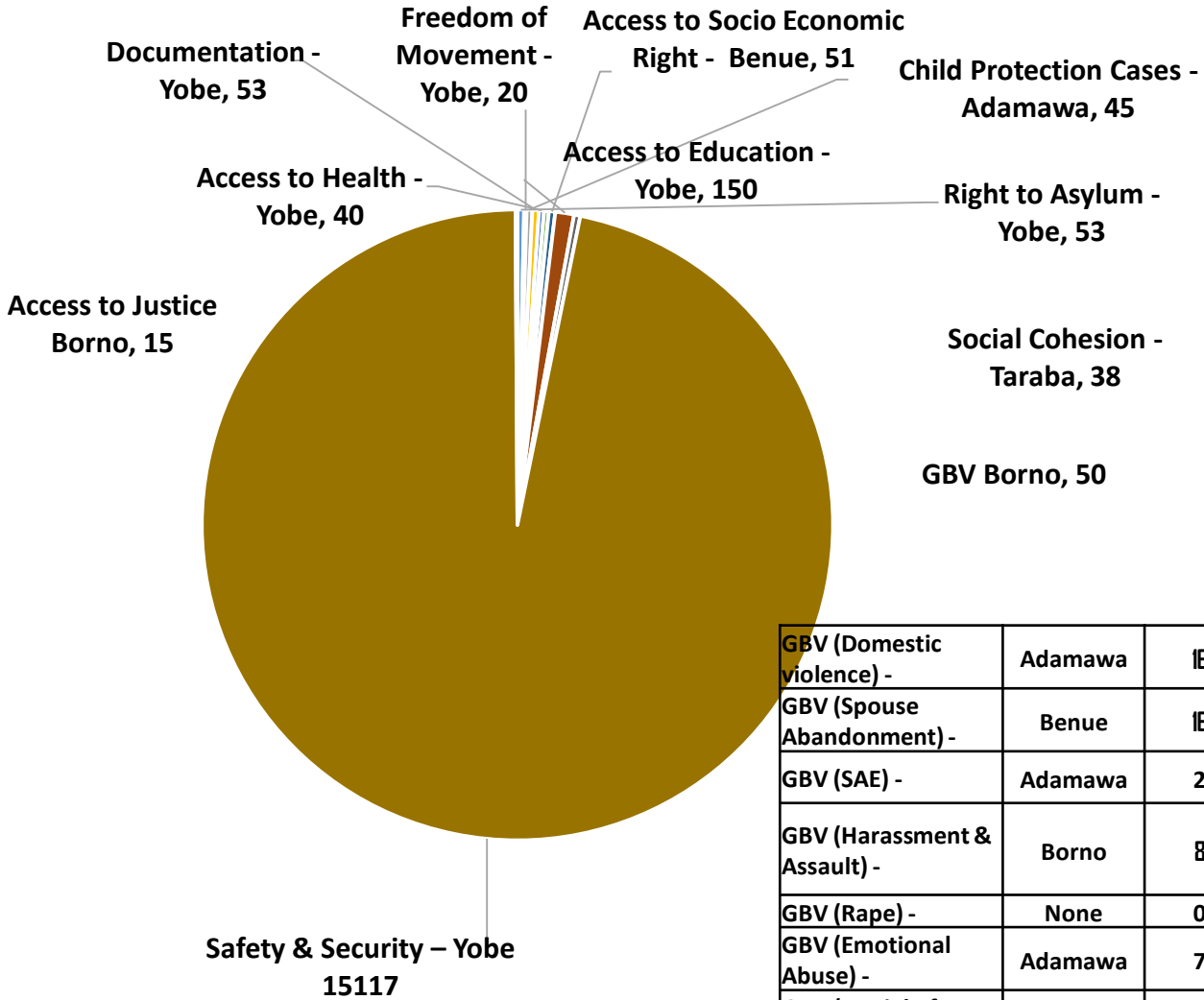

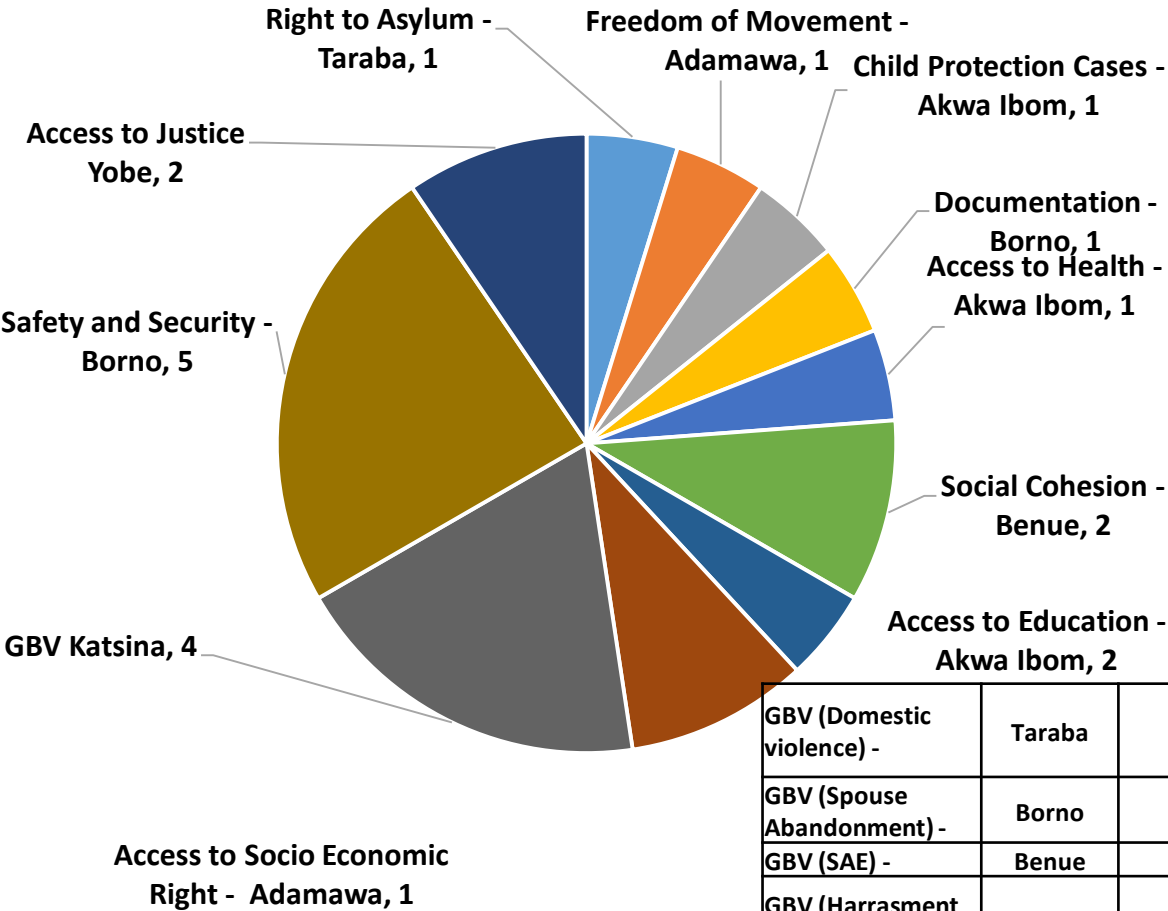

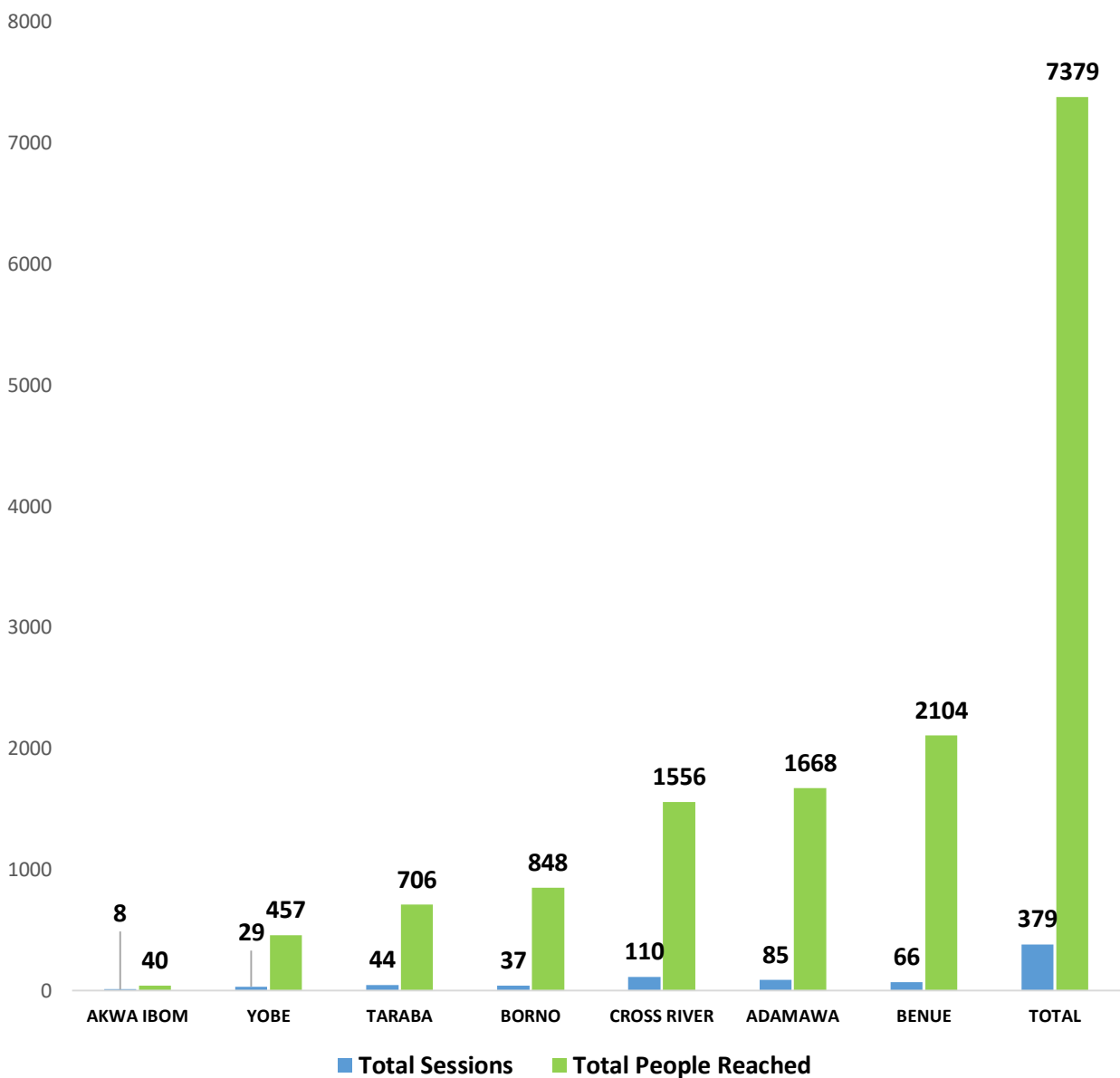

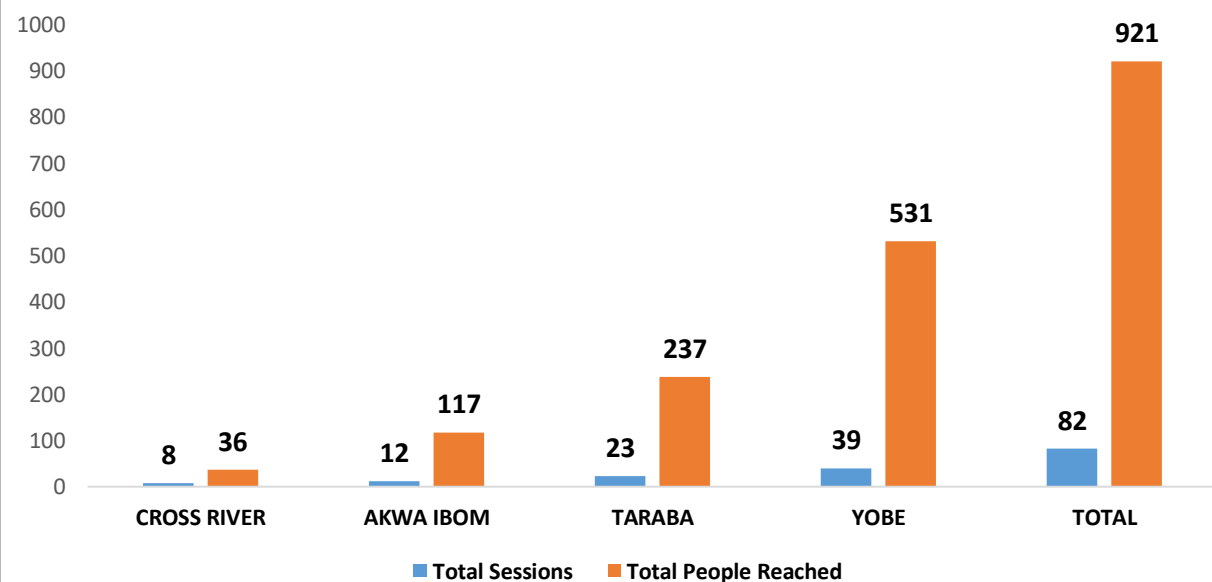

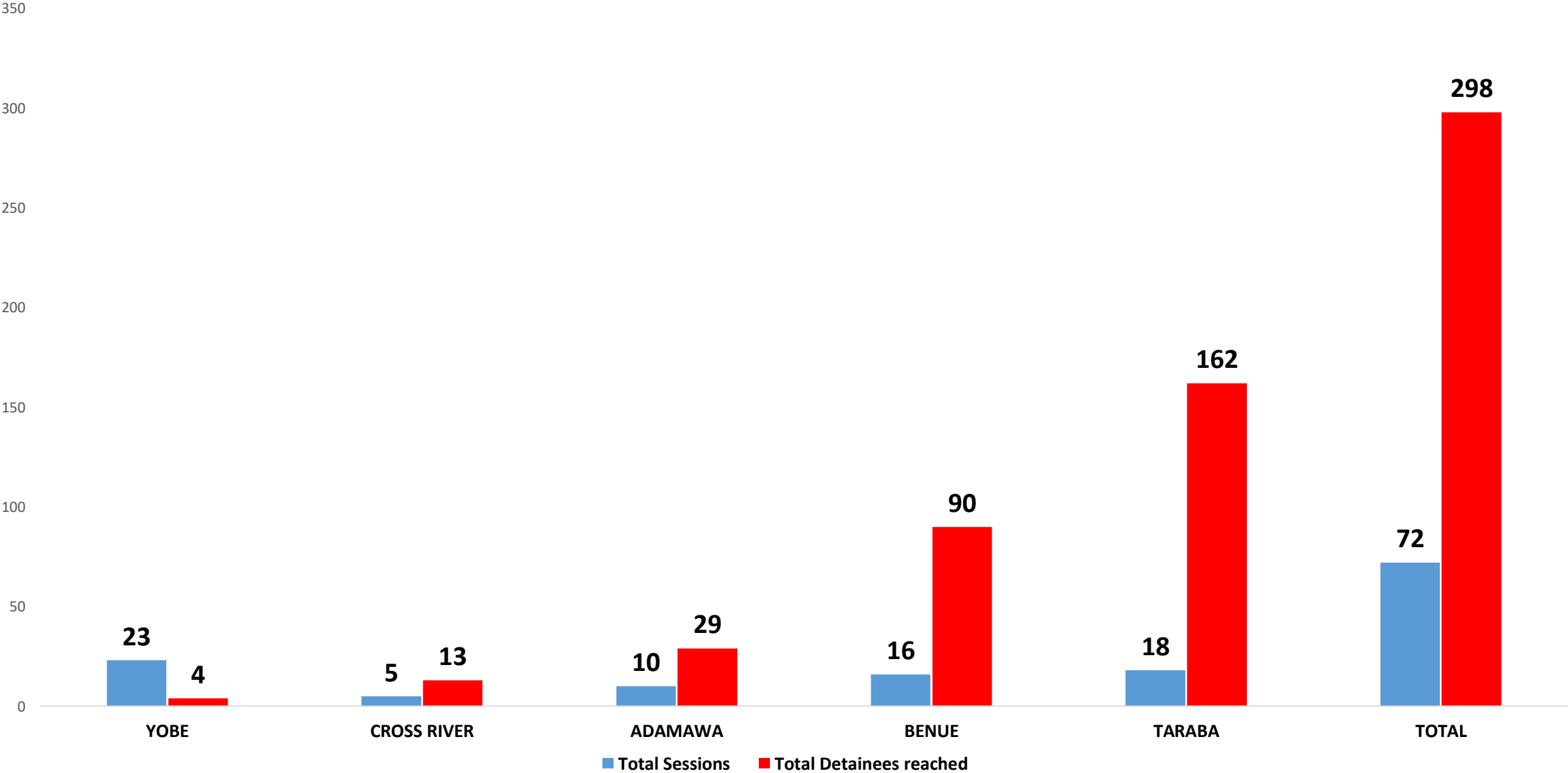

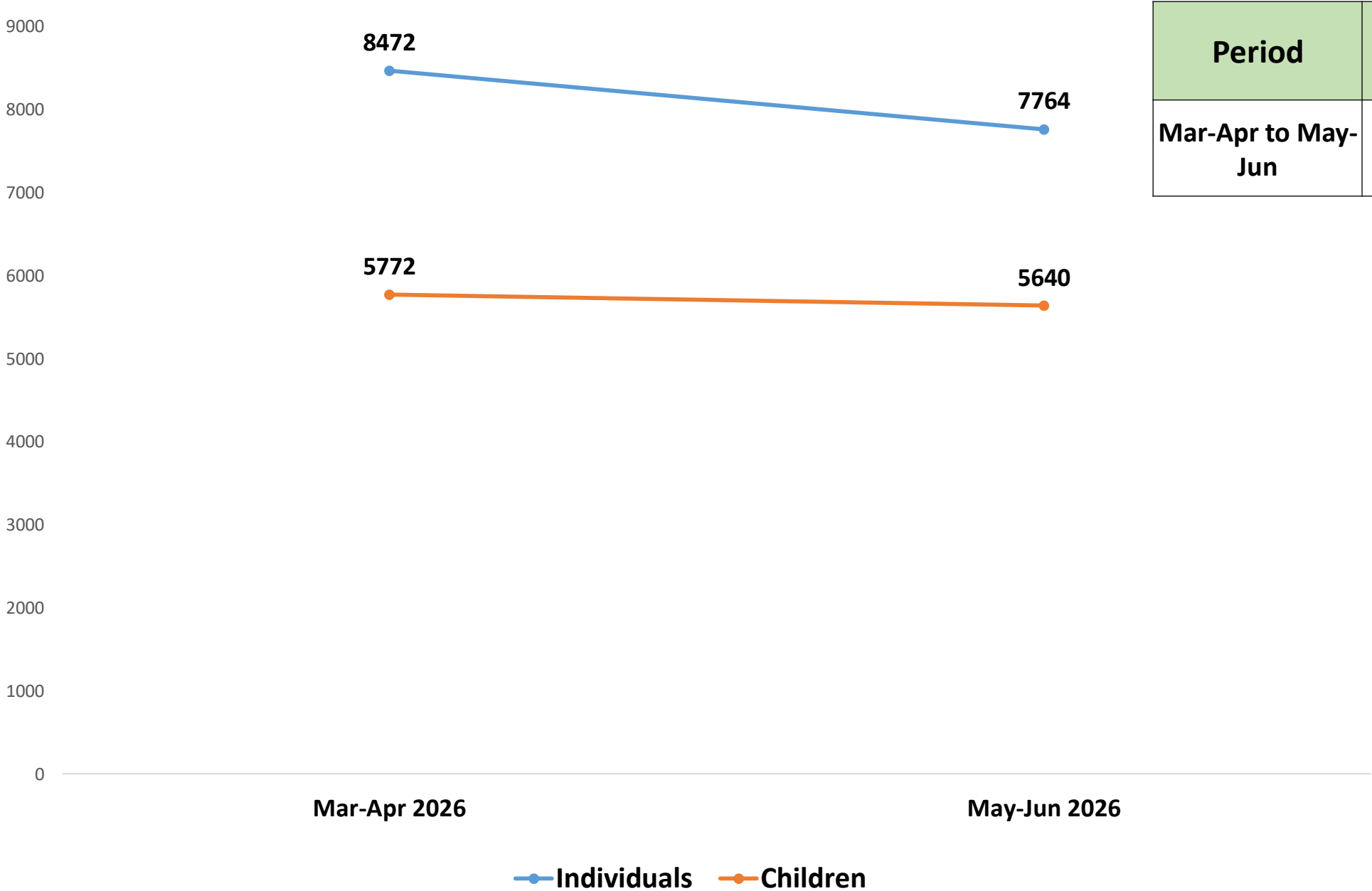

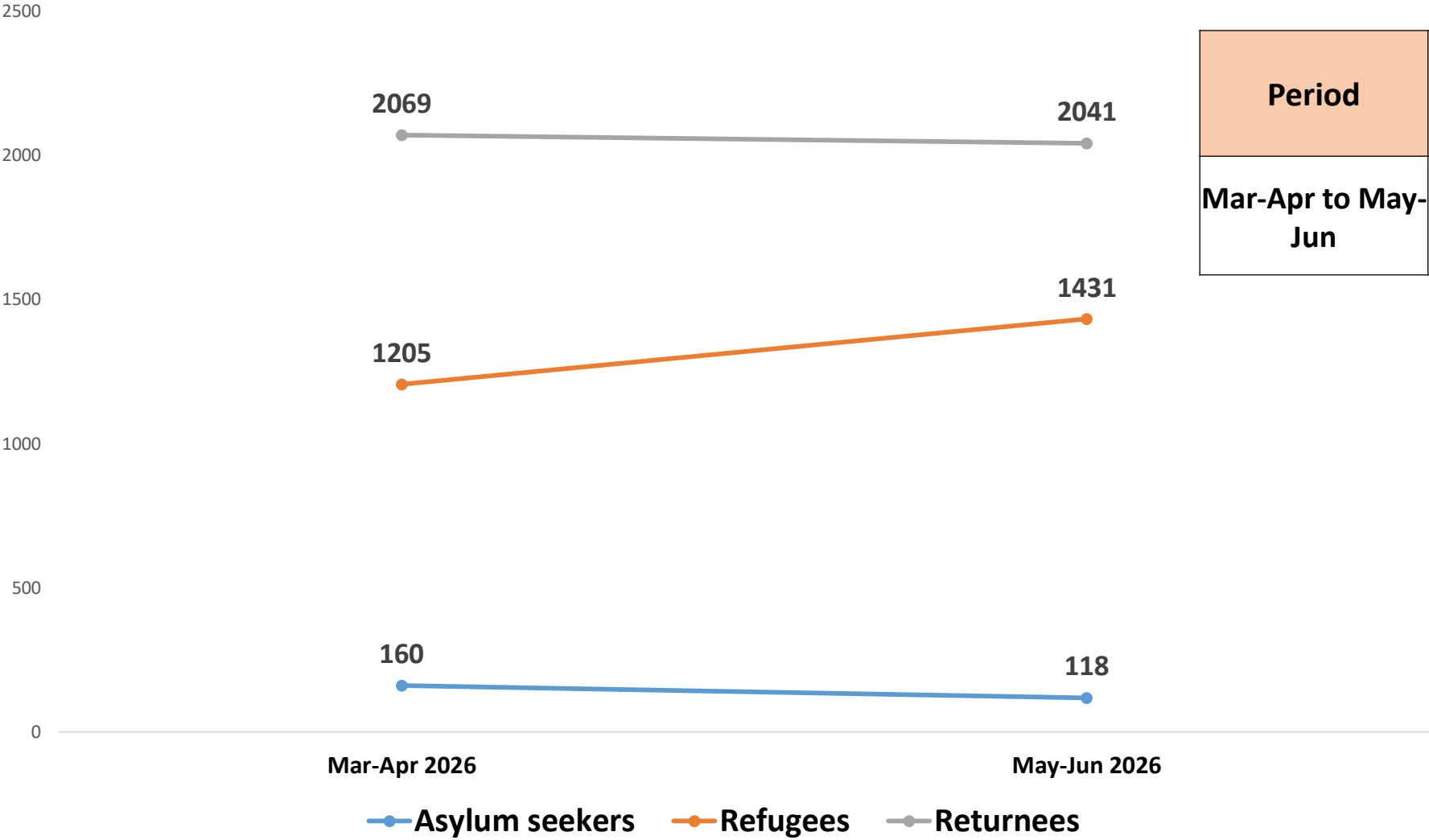

POSITIVE IMPACT / ACHIEVEMENTS – May and June 2026

1. **Multi-Sectoral Coordination:** Through protection sector working groups and coordination meetings, our teams have executed hundreds of referrals to address gaps in shelter, food, Non-Food Items (NFIs), WASH, and education.

2. **Rights Awareness & Enlightenment**

Community sensitization sessions continue to improve knowledge among FDPs and host communities regarding human rights, Gender Based Violence prevention, and available reporting channels..

POSITIVE IMPACT...

Child Protection Wins/Documentation

- Children registered & issued birth certificates; rescued from abuse/exploitation; stopped child labour/ hawking.
- **Documentation/Civil Registration:** Through referrals to the National Population Commission and NIMC, many FDPs have obtained National Identification Numbers, enabling access to essential services.

POSITIVE IMPACT...

- **Breaking Silence on GBV**

Recorded and successfully managed and/or referred to appropriate agencies (Police, NSCDC, hospitals). Bringing relief to survivors

- **Combating Unlawful Detention/Improved Access to Justice**

Through detention center monitoring and case management, we have secured the release of arbitrarily detained persons, facilitated court appearances, and ensured perpetrators of human rights violations face justice.

POSITIVE IMPACT / ACHIEVEMENTS – May and June 2026 (cont)

. **Widows' Property Rights**

- Prevented unlawful seizure of a widow's inherited land in Maiha LGA through dialogue and mediation → land restored to the widow.

• **Enhanced Social Cohesion**

Community consultations with stakeholders → improved engagement between FDPs & host communities for peaceful coexistence.

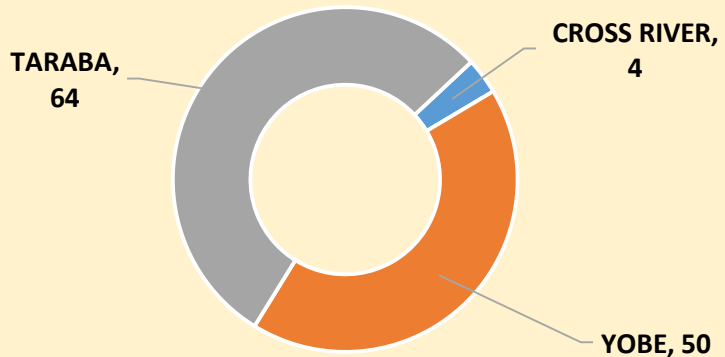

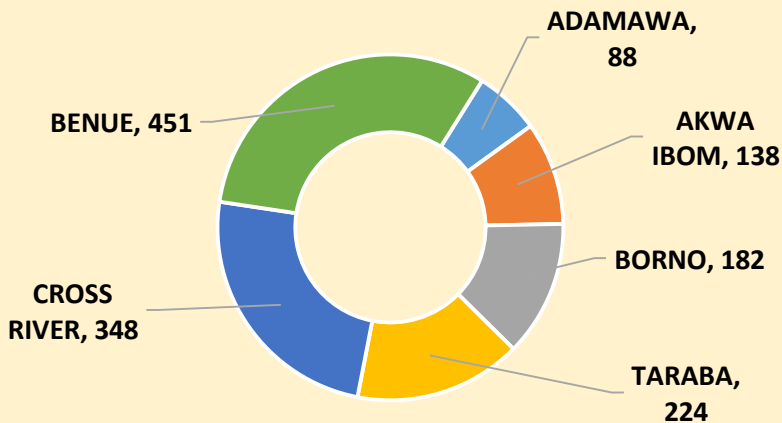
Detention Monitoring Visits To Detention Facilities

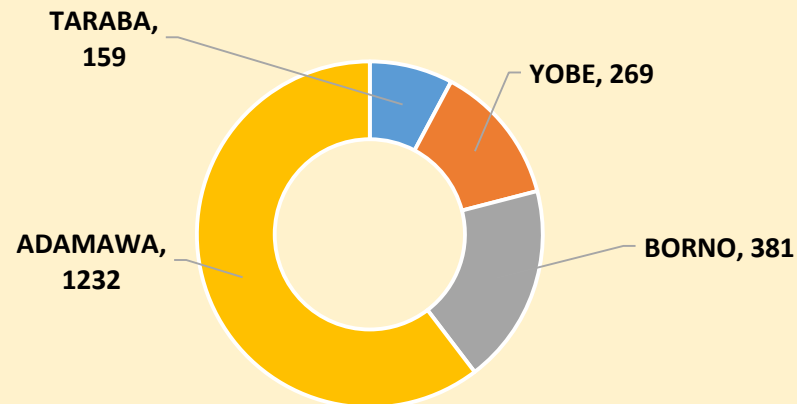
Total Asylum Seekers May-Jun 2026
