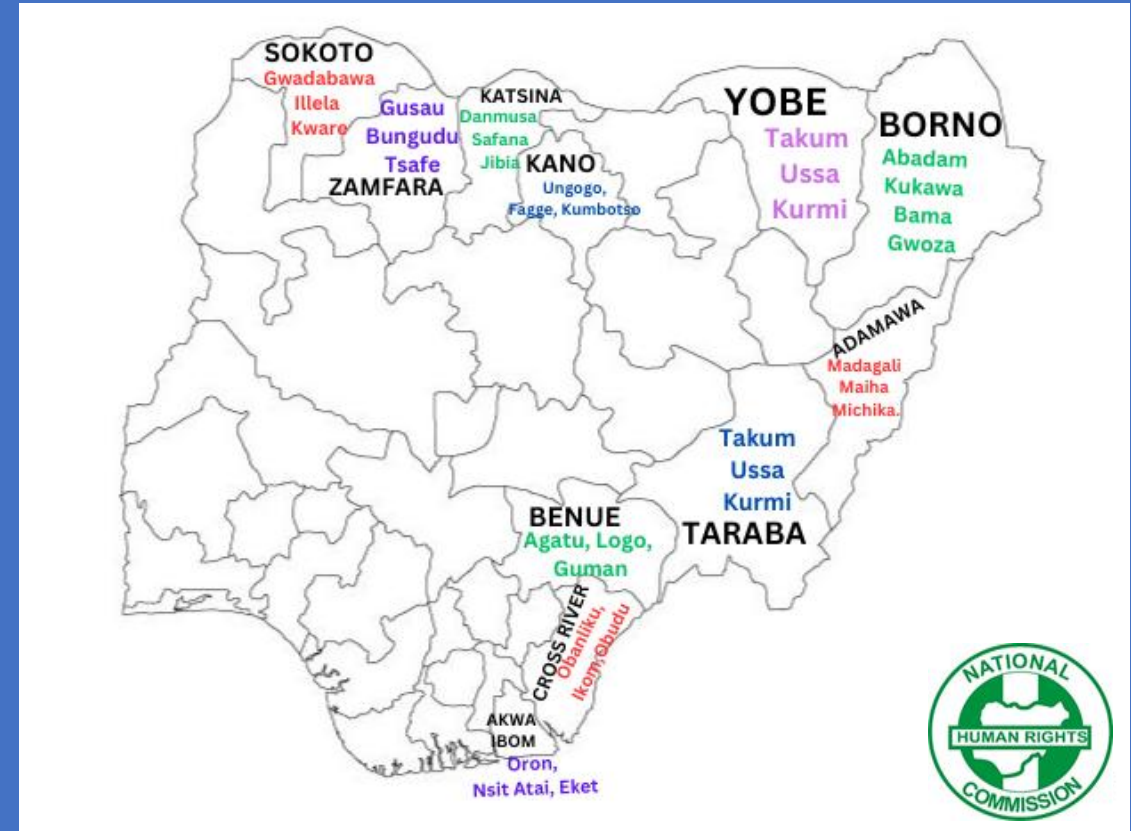

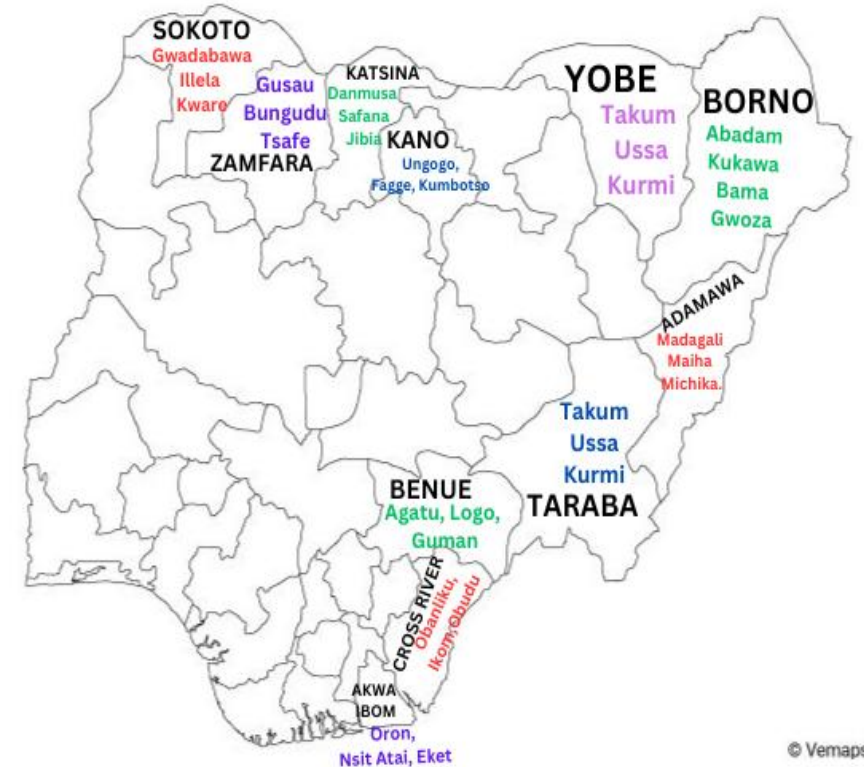

# Introduction

- Nigerian faces huge human rights and humanitarian unsalutary situation because of complex interplay of factors causing widespread forcible displacement.
- Forcible displacement in Nigeria has been acerbated by a combination of factors - Boko Haram/ISWAP violent extremism/activities, drought/desertification in the Northeast, armed banditry and criminalities in the Northwest and Northcentral, communal conflicts, floods and activities of 'unknown gunmen' have made matter worse in the south
- IDPs, Asylum-seekers, Refugees, and Returnees face human rights violatios and are denied access to social services such as WASH, health care/education, and access to justice/GBV/SGBV/SEA, safety/security, etc requiring protection.

# About the Project

- Project objective – Collection of information and data to promote awareness/understanding of FDPs/IDPs rights among IDPs communities, Government, security personnel, CSOs and development partners.
- Improve the promotion and protection of human rights of IDPs through multi-pronged intervention (advocacy, capacity building and hold duty bearers accountable to enhance policy and programming activities for durable solutions to the plight of IDPs)

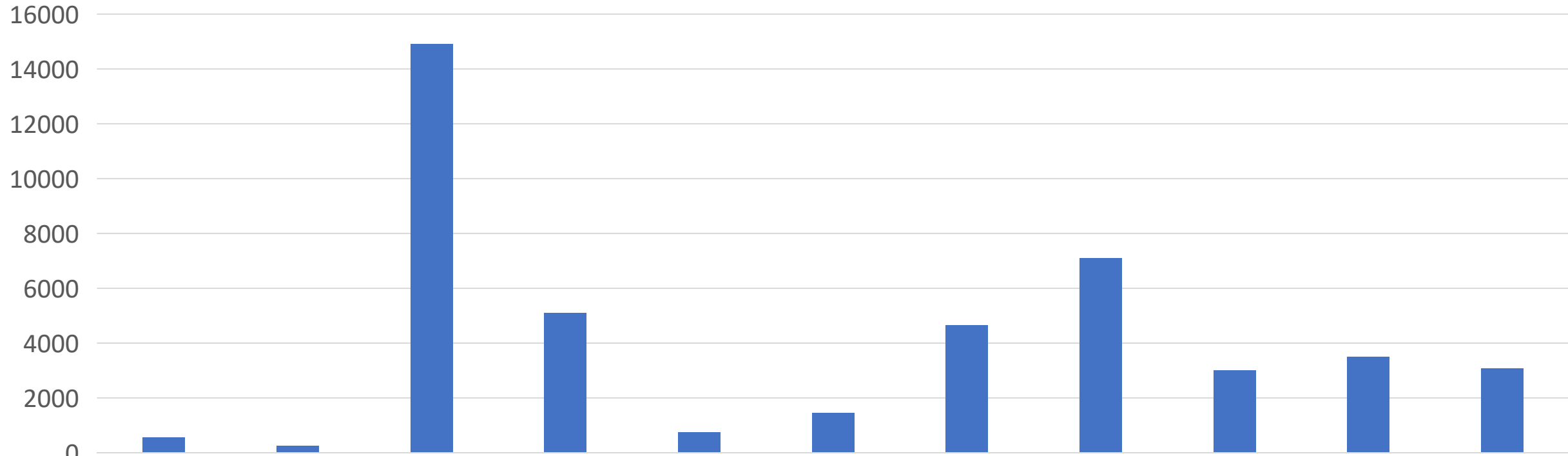

# Objectives of NHRC Dashboard on Human Rights and Internal Displacement in Nigeria

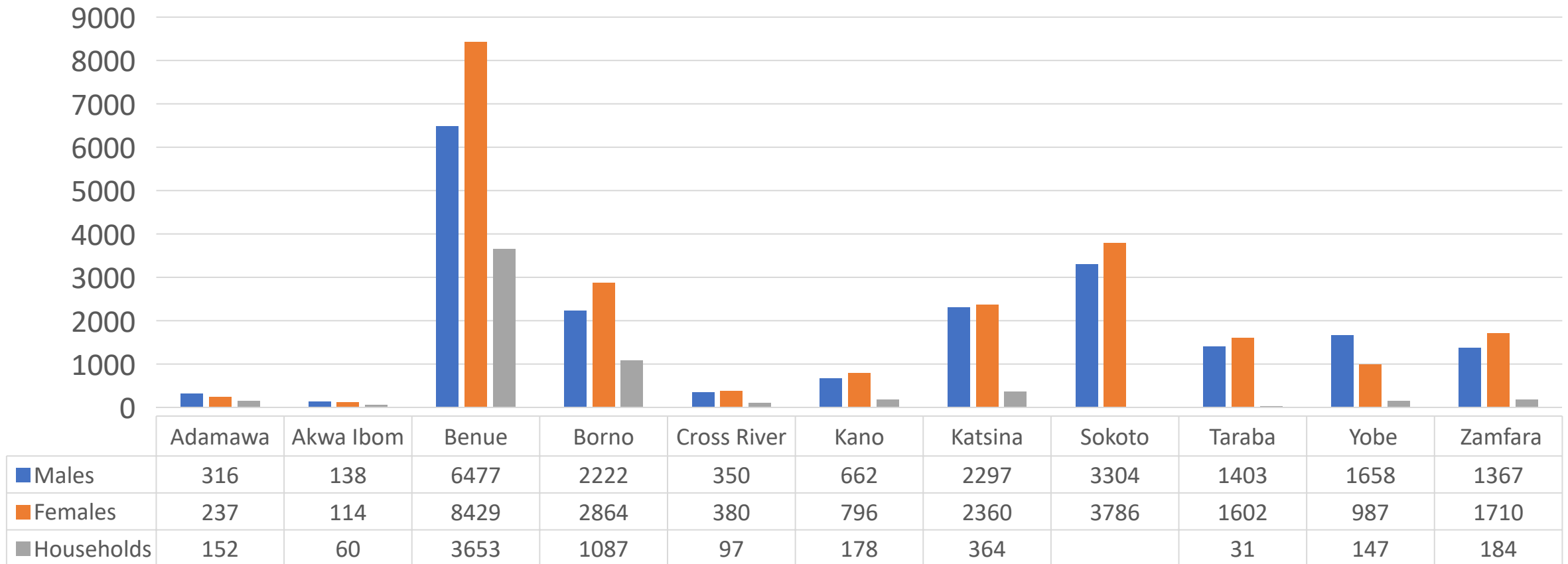
- Provide credible information on disaggregated data on human rights thematic issue-areas of IDPs to enable proactive intervention

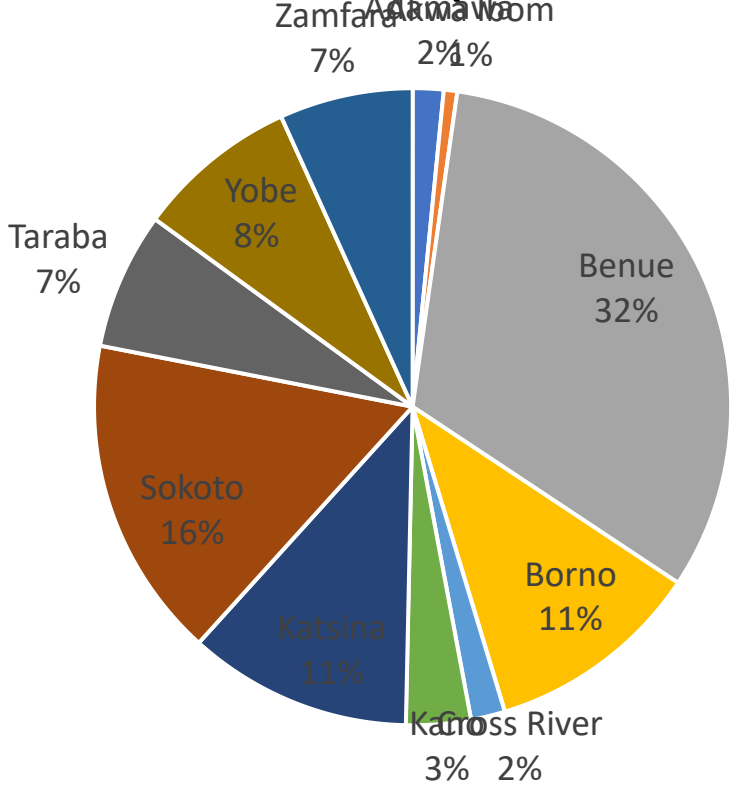
# Internal/Forced Displacements of Populations Feb - Apr. 2025



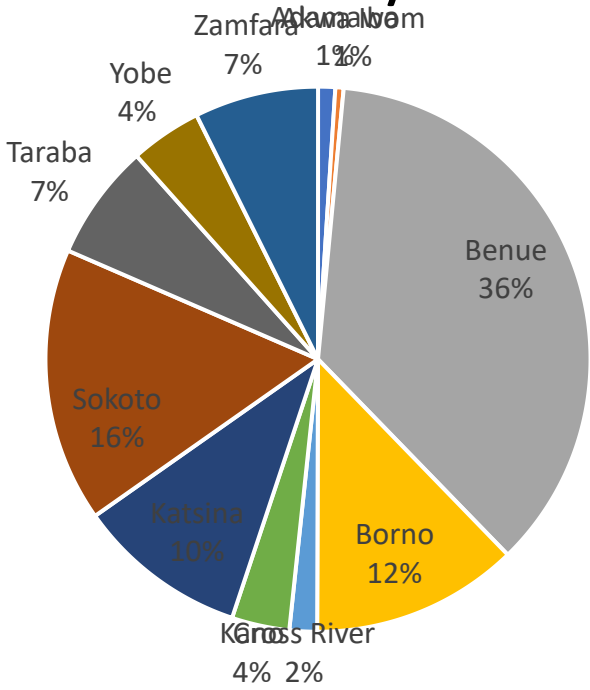

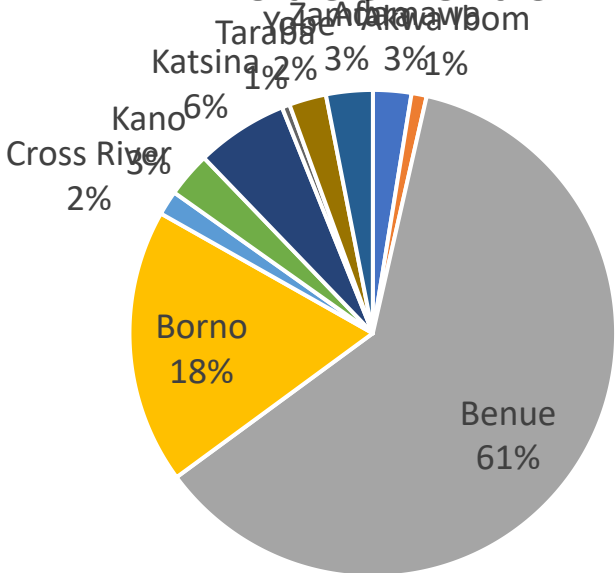

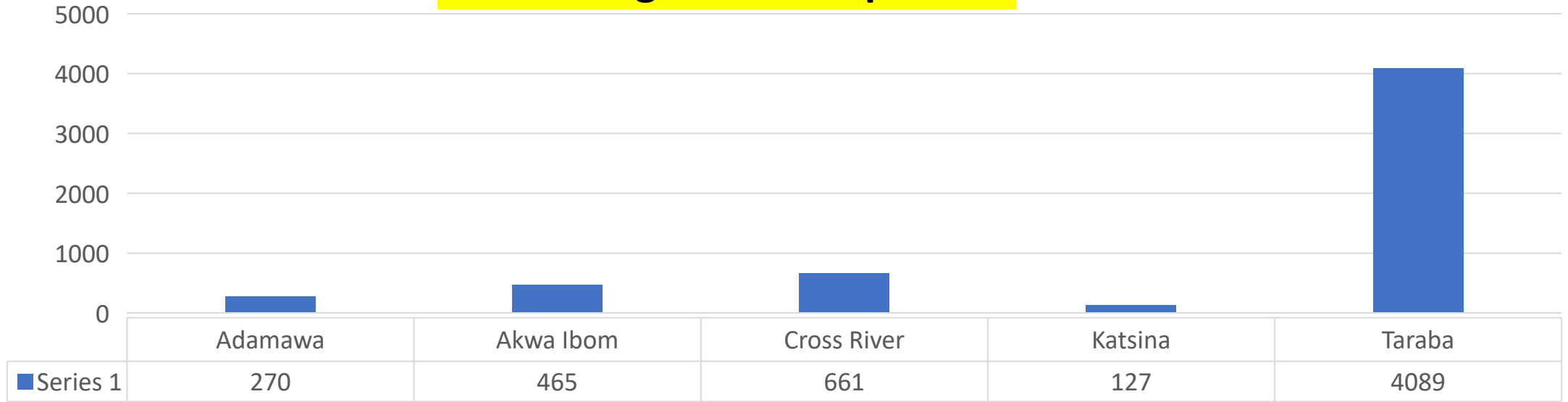

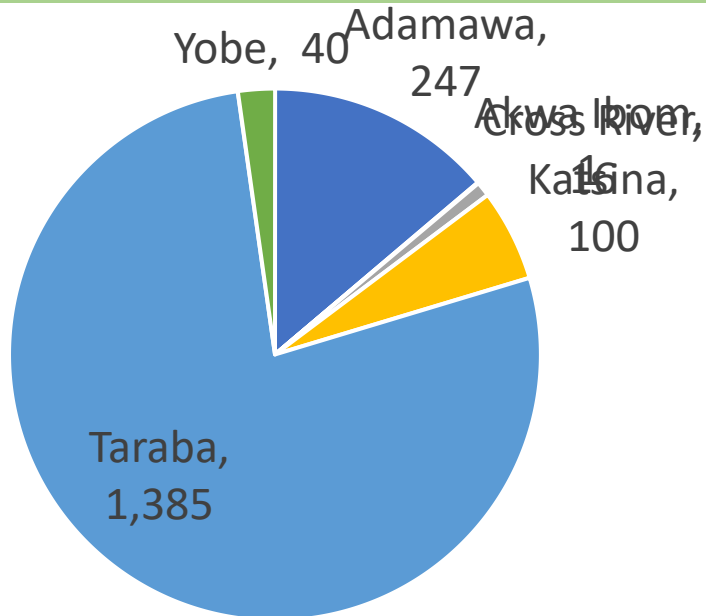

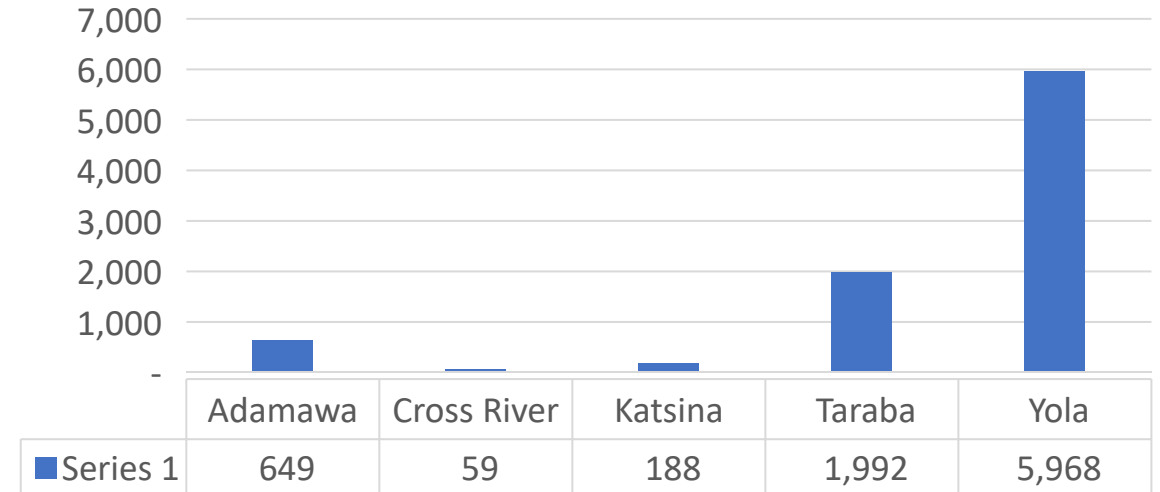

## Total Asylum Seekers Feb - Apr 2025

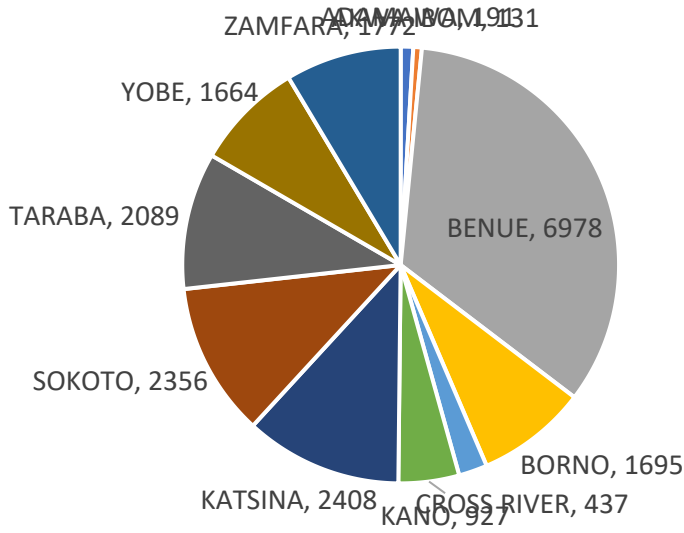

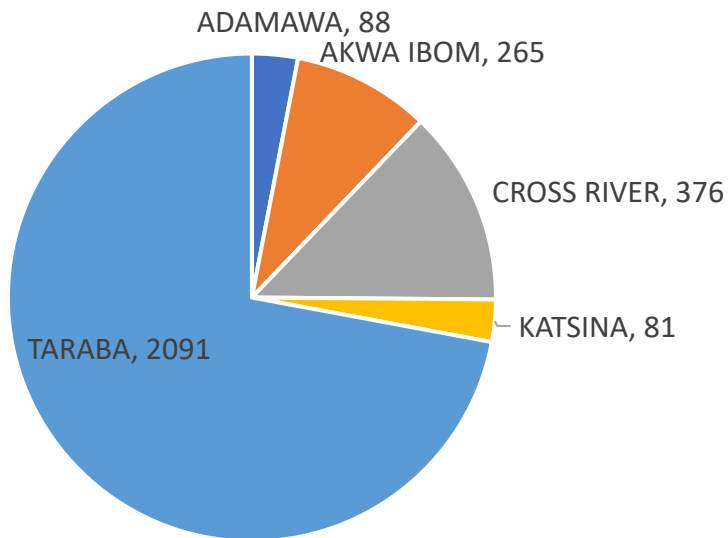

---

The Boko Haram insurgency and activities of other terror groups like ISWAP and Lakawura

---

Violence and Insecurity by Armed Banditry (Herders/ Farmers clashes)

Military operations, e.g. the air strikes and accidental killings of civilians – Zamfara, Sokoto and Kaduna states

---

Impacts of climate change – drought, desertification and loss of arable lands make people to live in search of livelihood

Closure of IDPs camps

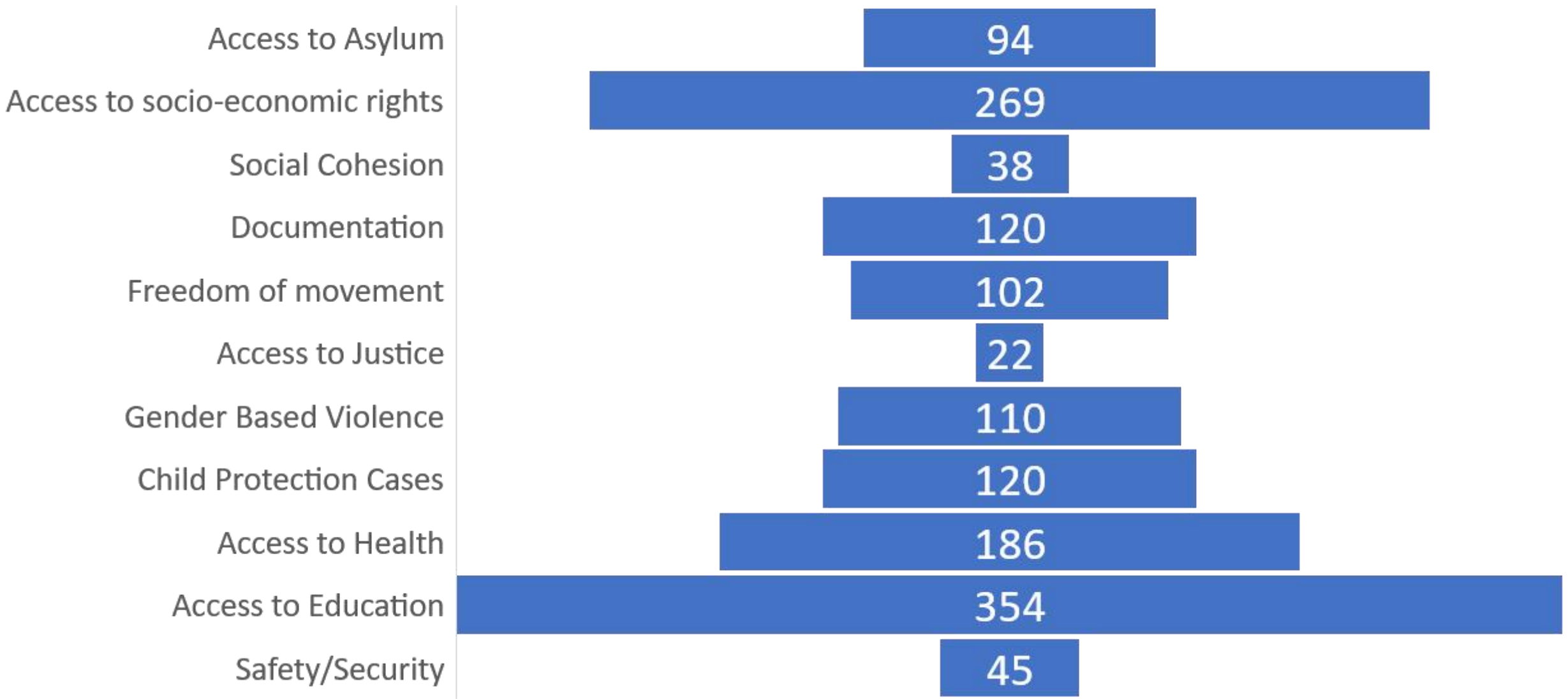

Inter-communal clashes – land, chieftaincy and boundary disputes. Eg, Cross River and Akwa Ibom States

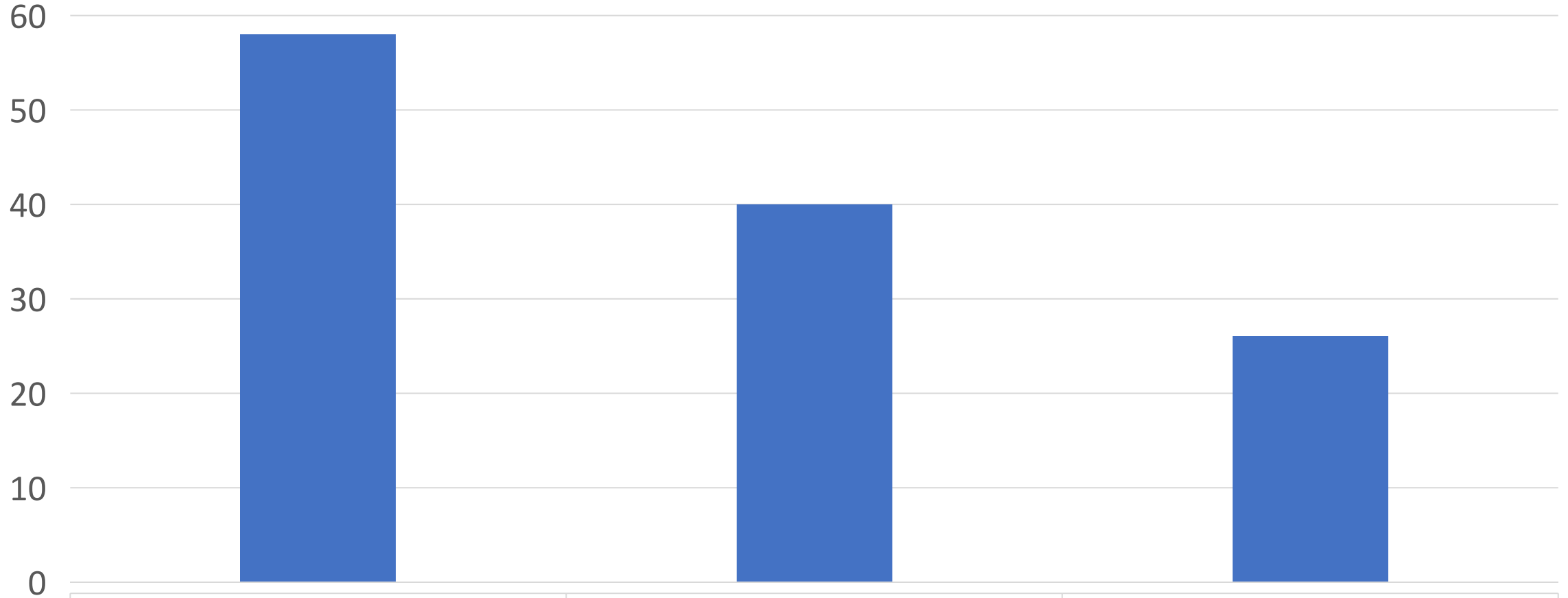

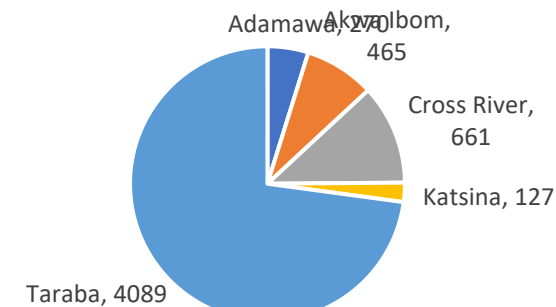
## CHILDREN IDPs/FDPs Feb - Apr 2025



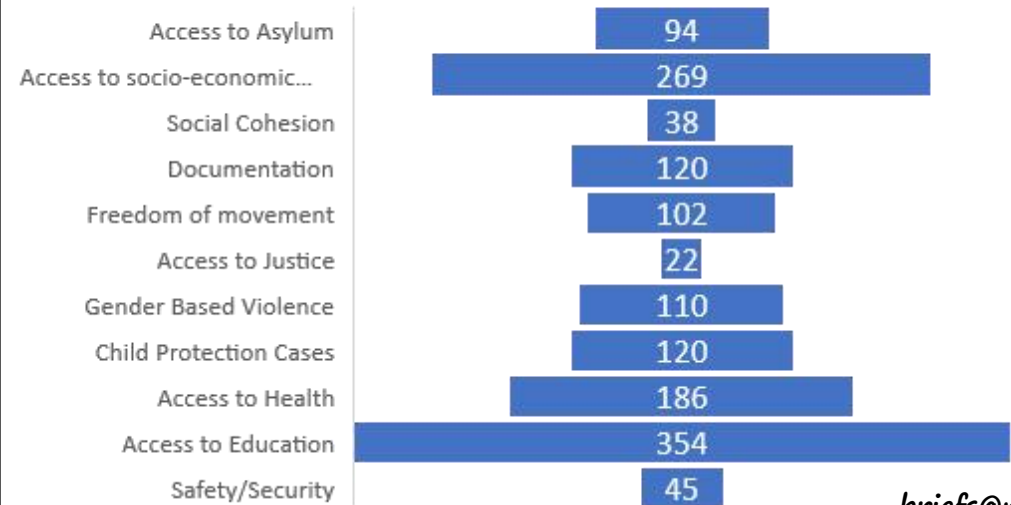
## Internally Displaced Persons & Forced Displaced Persons Feb - Apr 2025



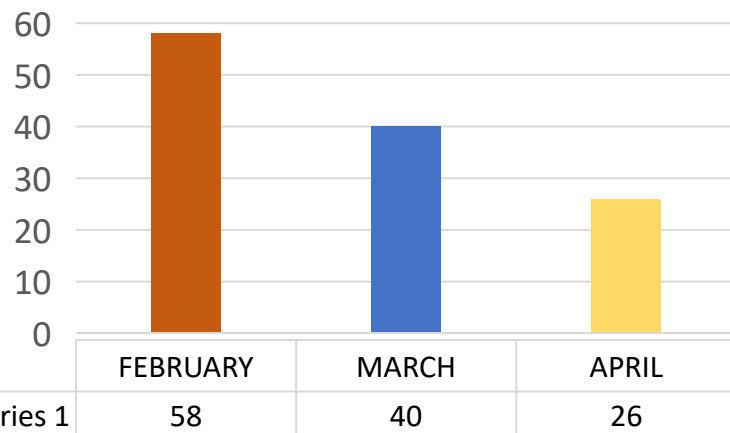
